TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To mark the 25th Anniversary of its formation, the AIJA established a biennial Award for Excellence in Judicial Administration. The Award is intended to recognise individuals or organisations who have made an exceptional contribution to the administration of justice in Australia. The first of these was awarded in 2002.

The AIJA invites nominations (including courts and other institutions) for the 2021 Award.

The closing date for nominations is **5 p.m. on 24 September 2021**.

Conditions of the Award are:

1. All nominations must be received by the Executive Director of the AIJA, Alison MacDonald, by email at alison.macdonald@aija.org.au no later than **5 p.m. on 24 September 2021 (AEST)**.
3. Each nomination will be accompanied by a completed nomination form, together with such supporting evidence as the nominator wishes to be considered.
4. The Executive Director of the AIJA will submit all nominations to a special review panel comprised of members of the AIJA Council.
5. The award will not be made if, in the opinion of the panel, no nomination worthy of an award is received.
6. A nomination may be resubmitted for consideration in a subsequent year of the award.
7. The panel will decide on or before 23 October 2021 who will receive the award.
8. No member of the panel nor any present member of the AIJA Council who holds executive office is eligible for the award.
